Subject: Federal data collection requirements (TEDS data)

Attention: Providers must assure that the appropriate assessment is conducted for all members who receive federal funds (Medicaid or other state funding) for their mental health or SUD treatment.

TEDS data collection

Magellan of Idaho will collect Combined Mental Health and SUD Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS) data to complete federal reporting as required by SAMHSA.

To collect this data, Magellan Providers will use the outcomes and assessment system available in <u>Availity Essentials.</u>

- Data must be collected on all members as of July 1, 2024.
- To allow providers to adapt to the new Availity Essentials portal, Magellan has given all
 Providers a grace period for data entry into the portal of 90 days. This means that data from July
 1, 2024, forward must be entered into Availity by October 1, 2024.
- As of October 1, 2024, providers must have all TEDS data submitted in real time, within a 30-day period.

TEDS data collection on patients under age 12

The scope of eligible clients is to include patients under the age of 12. This is to ensure consistency with SAMHSA Uniform Reporting Systems (URS) reporting. Data should be reported for all child and adult clients.
