Subject: Wraparound Intensive Services (WInS) provider requirement updates

Attention: New change in provider requirements for Wraparound Intensive Services (WInS)

Overview of changes

Idaho Department of Health and Welfare (IDHW) recently received new guidance from CMS regarding care coordination that impacts Wraparound Intensive Services (WInS) provider requirements. Previously, providers who offered other Medicaid-funded services could not become an in-network provider of WInS. Providers can now offer WInS if they do not offer respite services or if they have a rural exemption. Magellan and IDHW will work with CMS on approval for rural exemptions as necessary.

Next steps

Magellan will collaborate with IDHW to host provider forums to present this new change and how to become a WInS provider.
