Subject: Magellan Care Guidelines update takes effect Jan. 1

Attention: Updated Magellan Care Guidelines for Idaho Behavioral Health Plan (IBHP)

## **Overview**

The updated Magellan Care Guidelines (MCG) for the Idaho Behavioral Health Plan (IBHP) will be effective Jan. 1, 2025. The updated version will continue to include Magellan Healthcare Guidelines for IBHP, MCG Behavioral Health Care Guidelines (now 28<sup>th</sup> edition) developed by MCG Health® and The ASAM Criteria®, 3rd edition.

There are no substantiative changes from the guidelines currently in use, except for the guideline for transcranial magnetic stimulation. Magellan is adopting the 28<sup>th</sup> edition MCG Behavioral Health Guideline "Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation" and retiring its Magellan Healthcare "Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation" clinical guideline currently in use.

## This change results in:

- Slightly less restrictive clinical criteria
- Moving from a requirement of two failed trials from two different classes or inability to tolerate
  psychopharmacologic agents as evidenced by two trials from at least two different agent
  classes; to trials from two or more classes of antidepressants of adequate duration and dosage
  or inability to tolerate psychopharmacology as evidenced from two trials of agents with
  documented side effects
- Demonstrated failed trial of evidence-based psychotherapy is no longer required.
