# **Updated wraparound criteria**

Magellan has updated the wraparound services criteria; these criteria are currently in effect. Wraparound services require youth to meet all of the following:

#### **CANS** score

An overall CANS (Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths) level score of 2 or 3.

## Multi-system involvement

- Behavioral health need and/or participation in at least one additional child-serving system, such as:
  - Court involvement
  - Child Protection Services (CPS)
  - Education needs (IEP, 504 Plan, or goal to improve educational performance)
  - Physical health needs
  - Developmental or intellectual disabilities

### Willingness to participate

• Youth and family must be motivated to engage in the wraparound care planning process, with an average length of 12-14 months.

#### Need for intensive care coordination

 Youth and family can benefit from intensive care coordination and/or have not seen progress with current care coordination efforts.

### **Additional indicators**

Wraparound may also be appropriate for youth experiencing:

- Risk of out-of-home placement
- Transition needs from higher levels of behavioral health interventions, such as:
  - Intensive home- and community-based services
  - Intensive outpatient programs
  - o Partial hospitalization
  - Residential care or hospitalization
