Subject: Alert: SOR & SUPTR funding paused for select ASAM levels

Attention: SOR & SUPTR substance use disorder (SUD) funding changes

Overview

Effective **Monday, March 17**, new admissions to the following levels of care for SOR and SUPTR SUD funding will be temporarily unavailable for the following ASAM levels of care:

- **ASAM 2.5**: Partial Hospitalization Program
- **ASAM 3.1**: Low-Intensity Residential Treatment
- ASAM 3.5: Residential SUD

Members with current authorization for these services may continue receiving care until it is determined that the services are no longer medically necessary.

Magellan will provide additional information closer to July 1, 2025, in regard to when funding for these levels of care will be available again.

The Department of Health and Welfare and Magellan appreciate your understanding as we navigate service changes. Due to higher-than-expected expenditures this fiscal year, we are working together to optimize benefit administration while serving as many eligible members as possible.

Members who qualify for SOR/SUPTRS still have access to other services such as intensive outpatient, outpatient services, and recovery and support services such as case management and recovery coaching.
