Subject: Adult peer support services resume April 13

Overview

With the recent signing of legislation reinstating adult peer support services, Magellan has reinstated these services for Idaho Behavioral Health Plan members, aged 18 and up.

Beginning Monday, April 13, providers who were previously and appropriately credentialed to provide adult peer support services may resume providing these services immediately.

Providers who were not previously credentialed to provide adult peer support services, or who have questions related to credentialing requirements, should contact their Magellan network representative or email IdahoProvider@MagellanHealth.com for assistance.

Voluntary Provider Poll
