Subject: Clarification: Allowable diagnosis codes for SUPTR-funded members

Overview

This communication clarifies information shared in our Jan. 29, 2026, email regarding [allowable primary diagnoses and code ranges](#) for members funded through Substance Use Prevention, Treatment and Recovery (SUPTR) and State Opioid Response (SOR) funding.

This is not a new requirement. The information below clarifies existing guidance and applies to all providers delivering services to members with a substance use disorder (SUD).

Allowable diagnosis codes for SUPTR-funded members

For SUPTR funded members, allowable primary diagnosis codes fall within the following range:

- **F10.10–F19.99:** Mental and behavioral disorders due to psychoactive substance use

However, certain primary diagnosis codes within this range are excluded because they are associated with SOR funded members and are not allowable for SUPTR funding.

The following primary diagnosis code ranges are *excluded* from SUPTR:

- **F11.10–F11.99:** Opioid-related mental and behavioral disorders
- **F14.10–F14.99:** Cocaine-related mental and behavioral disorders
- **F15.10–F15.99:** Other stimulant-related mental and behavioral disorders

Use these excluded codes only when services are funded through SOR, consistent with existing guidance.
