Subject: Update: SOR & SUPTR SUD funding paused for select ASAM levels until further notice

Attention: Update to State Opioid Response (SOR) & Substance Use Prevention Treatment and Recovery (SUPTR) substance use disorder (SUD) program

Overview

Magellan Healthcare previously sent a communication stating that effective **Monday, March 17, 2025**, new admissions to the following ASAM levels of care for SOR and SUPTR SUD funding will be temporarily unavailable:

- ASAM 2.5: Partial Hospitalization Program
- ASAM 3.1: Low-Intensity Residential Treatment
- ASAM 3.5: Residential SUD

Members with authorizations, as of March 17, 2025, for these services were allowed to continue receiving care until it was determined that the services are no longer medically necessary.

Magellan stated that we would provide additional information closer to July 1, 2025, regarding when funding will be available again for these levels of care.

Updated information

New authorizations for the aforementioned levels of care will remain temporarily unavailable. Additional communication regarding access to these levels of care will be forthcoming.

The Department of Health and Welfare and Magellan appreciate your understanding as we navigate service changes.

Members who qualify for SOR/SUPTRS still have access to other services such as intensive outpatient, outpatient, and recovery and support services (e.g., case management and recovery coaching).
