**Subject:** Reminder: Timely filing requirements for state-funded services

## Overview

Magellan is reminding providers of timely filing requirements for services funded by other state programs. This requirement applies to all non-Medicaid services, including situations where a member is enrolled in Medicaid but the service is paid using other state funding sources.

## Timely filing requirement

- You must submit claims for state-funded services within 60 days of the date of service.
- This includes services for:
  - Substance Use Disorder (SUD)
    - This includes Substance Use Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery (SUPTR), and State Opioid Response (SOR) funded services.
  - Adult Mental Health (AMH)
  - Children's Mental Health (CMH)
- This requirement also applies to hospital claims for holds and commitments when services are funded through state dollars.

## Important reminders

- Timely filing requirements apply to any services funded by the state, even if the member also has Medicaid coverage.
- Claims not submitted within the required timeframe will be denied for payment.
- Ensure that billing staff are aware of these requirements to avoid claim denials.
