Subject: Upcoming update: Changes to IDAPA Medicaid rules reflected

in Provider Handbook Supplement

Attention: IDAPA rule language updated in IBHP Provider Handbook Supplement

Overview

Magellan Healthcare is updating the IBHP Provider Handbook Supplement to reflect recent changes to Idaho Medicaid rules.

Effective **July 1, 2025**, the following rule changes will go into effect:

- **IDAPA 16.03.09** (Medicaid Basic Plan Benefits) and **IDAPA 16.03.10** (Medicaid Enhanced Plan Benefits) will no longer be effective.
- A new, consolidated proposed and temporary rule set will be located under IDAPA 16.03.26.

This update reflects Idaho's transition to a single, streamlined Medicaid rule chapter and will be included in the next provider handbook supplement release on July 1.
