The ESMI program provides early intervention and recovery-focused care for adolescents and young adults experiencing first-episode psychosis (FEP). This coordinated, research-informed approach helps individuals manage symptoms, avoid higher levels of care such as hospitalization, and successfully transition to community-based supports.

We will provide an overview of the program, including expectations, reimbursement details, and other key information. Additionally, Magellan will collaborate with the Center of Excellence to introduce the ESMI Competency Center and outline the training and consultation support available to help providers successfully implement and deliver ESMI services.
