

Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS) Quick Tips - 1st Edition

When should I submit a Combined Behavioral Health Assessment in Magellan's Outcomes & Assessments System (aka P-CIS or Opeeka)?

When a client starts and/or stops/discharges from services that are not covered by Medicaid and have certain Substance Use Disorder (SUD) or Mental Health (MH) treatment. In some cases, a client may lose their Medicaid eligibility and be covered by grant funding. A TEDS assessment would be needed in these cases.

Important Note: Please be sure to submit an *Admission Record* before submitting a *Discharge Record*.

What services should I submit a TEDS records for?

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Why do I need to submit a Combined BH Assessment?

The Combined BH Assessment has two functions:

- 1) It collects TEDS data for reporting to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), which in turn helps research and funding allocations.
- 2) It contains a Comprehensive Diagnostic Assessment (CDA).

Do I need to fill out the entire Combined BH Assessment?

No, there is conditional logic based on what you need to fill out. Magellan's provider manual sets expectations that a provider perform a CDA and the Combined BH Assessment is available if you do not have an electronic health record system to document your own CDA.

The FASTEST way to fill out TEDS information is to select:

- 1) TEDS Admission Data Only (for treatment start) and/or
- 2) TEDS Discharge Only. Conditional logic will put a red asterisk(*) next to the minimum mandatory fields, feel free to skip everything else.

How to ensure your admission is classified as SUD or MH:

Ignore past substance use and reframe this question as “are you treating the member for SUD or MH disorder?”

- “No” will classify your submission as a MH record and it will not allow you to choose SUD treatment.
- “Yes” will classify your submission as an SUD record and it will not allow you to choose MH treatment.
