Overview

Magellan is now recruiting participants for the 2026 Member and Family Advisory Committee (MFAC). We are asking for your support in sharing this opportunity with Idaho Behavioral Health Plan (IBHP) members and parents/caregivers who may be interested.

What is the MFAC?

The MFAC is made up of IBHP members and parents/caregivers who have experience using IBHP mental health or substance use services. MFAC members provide valuable feedback that helps Magellan improve IBHP services and programs.

Who can apply?

Individuals are eligible to apply if they:

- Have used IBHP mental health or substance use services, or
- Are a parent, family member, or caregiver who has supported someone receiving IBHP services.

What is the meeting schedule?

The 2026 MFAC will meet online on the third Thursday every other month from 1–2 p.m. MT / 12–1 p.m. PT for a total of 6 meetings. The meeting dates are:

- Apr. 16, 2026, 1-2 p.m. MT / 12-1 p.m. PT
- June 18, 2026, 1-2 p.m. MT / 12-1 p.m. PT
- Aug. 20, 2026, 1-2 p.m. MT / 12-1 p.m. PT
- Oct. 15, 2026, 1-2 p.m. MT / 12-1 p.m. PT
- Dec. 17, 2026, 1-2 p.m. MT / 12-1 p.m. PT

Is compensation available?

MFAC members receive \$75 for each meeting they attend. To receive this payment, members must:

- Attend at least 75% of the meeting
- Be willing to share personal experiences

Please note:

- Additional instructions for receiving compensation will be provided to MFAC members.
- This payment may be considered income for Medicaid or other programs. Members may decline payment if they choose.
- MFAC members participate as individuals, not as representatives of providers or organizations.
